Learn to assemble a 60 Watt photovoltaic (PV) module for producing electricity, utilizing encapsulation process capable of charging 12 volt batteries which can be used for a RV, cabin, or small home PV system.

On the first day you will build a solar panel and the second day an irrigation system.

Professor **Richard Komp**, PhD, has researched and experimented with solar and other renewable energy technologies for over 50 years. His off-the-grid house in Maine is decked out with photovoltaics, solar thermal hot water and rain water catchments. He hasn't paid electric bills for 21 years. Dr. Komp is the author of several books including *"Practical Photovoltaics."*
