COMMON NAME	BOTANICAL NAME	LOCATION	DESCRIPTION	TYPE
Amaryllis	<i>Hippeastrum hybridum</i>	Full sun to light shade	Longstop light leaves. Flowers are red and orange, or white trumpet shaped blooms	Hardy perennial
Bleeding Heart	<i>Clerodendrum thomsoniae</i>	Sun to partial shade; rich soil; average water	Red-pink flowers, blooms late spring, summer and fall. Propagates easily from woody stems cuttings.	Perennial evergreen, twining, sprawling vine with Ivy-like foliage and long-blooming flower clusters.
Bottlebrush	<i>Callistemon rigidus</i>	Full sun, Drought and salt tolerant	Distinctive red bottlebrush shaped blooms spring and summer; attracts Hummingbirds and butterflies.	Evergreen small tree 10'-15' x 10'-15' spread.
Bougainvillea	<i>Bougainvillea spectabilis</i>	Full sun to partial shade; well draining soil	Flowers can be several different colors: from pink, to red to orange, to white and yellow. Plant will reach over 30'	Evergreen vine type (red flower only) or Shrub
Bush morning glory	<i>Ipomoea carnea</i>	Full sun	Vine with bright blue flowers.	Perennial
Canna Lily Red	<i>Canna indica</i>	Full Sun requires consistently moist soil; do not let dry out between waterings; acidic soil	Grows 36"-48" plant 9"-12" apart; blooms repeatedly most all year long; wide range of bloom colors. Propagate by dividing rhizomes or seeds. Spreads quickly.	Herbaceous flowering perennial

Compassion Rose	<i>Rosa compassion</i>	Full sun; medium water	Large soft apricot to salmon pink flowers; large red thorns; prune each Spring; 10' by 6'	Vigorous, upright climber with moderate spread; strong fragrance
Confederate Jasmine	<i>Trachelospermum jasminoides</i>	Full sun, drought resistant	Small, shiny dark green leaves which provide a dense screen or cover. Fragrant clusters of small pinwheel shaped flowers.	Fast growing flowering twining vine, may be pruned into small bush
Cranberry Hibiscus, False Roselle	<i>Hibiscus acetosella</i>	Full Sun, part shade, moderate water	Species of Hibiscus dark maroon-colored leaves mauve-pink flowers. The leaves and flowers are edible with tart flavor.	A perennial shrub lanky growth habit; 6'-8' tall.
Morning Glory, Tievine	<i>Ipomoea cordatotriloba</i>	Drought/salt tolerance medium, full sun/part shade	2 types leaves on same plant, tri-lobed and heart shaped. Lg. lavender or pink funnel-shaped flowers. Blooms irregularly throughout year, but mostly fall to late spring	Flowering vine, occasionally a groundcover
Queens wreath	<i>Petrea volubilis</i>	Part sun/part shade drought tolerant, poor salt tolerance	Green leaves w/ sand-papery texture; purple/blue star shaped flowers on foot long hanging clusters, blooms several times a year.	Rapid growing evergreen twining vine.
Red Passion Vine	<i>Passiflora coccinea</i>	Full sun	Height and spread varies depending upon supporting structure. Flowers red to deep orange	Evergreen flowering vine
Shaving Brush Tree	<i>Pseudobombax ellipticum</i>	full sun, well-drained soil, drought tolerance-moderate	Showy flowers are pink, red or white & shaped like a shaving brush.	Tree grows to 20'-30'
