¹ Commercial Certification Lawn & Ornamental	Commercial Pest Control Operators.	Residential, commercial and government properties.	3 years related employment. \$225 paid 3 months in advance.
(PCO) Chapter 482			Given 4 times annually in Winter Haven. (850) 921-4177.
² Limited Certification Lawn & Ornamental (L&O) Chapter 482	Government and private employees and business owners.	Government and private properties including: schools, hospitals, condos, club houses, gated communities, and restaurants. Not to include: parks or golf courses.	\$150 prepaid each time exam is taken. Extension given.
² Limited Certification Landscape Maintenance Chapter 482	Commercial landscapers.	Private residences, gated communities, and commercial properties. No lawn applications. Use of pesticides in ornamental areas only.	3 years related employment plus 8 hour class. \$150 prepaid each time exam is taken. Extension given.
³ Ornamental & Turf (O&T) Chapter 487	Commercial applicators, parks and recreation ground keepers, and nursery personnel.	Golf courses, sport turf, parks, nurseries, and cemeteries.	None. Extension given.
