Here is an opportunity for you to walk a primer landscape and discover what growing well and what had to be corrected. This tour will be conducted in a limited area and begin by the parking lot, then to the pump house and finally to the third floor atrium. Learn how Shell Point has adapted to the new fertilizer ordinance, how reclaimed water is used and how plants such as caladium, king sago, dwarf Carissa, dwarf allamanda, and Fakahatchee grass are used and maintained. Only a limited number of landscapers and HOA property managers can be accommodated on this tour.
