If you cut lawns and maintain ornamentals at private homes and wish to apply pesticides, *including Round-Up*, on the job, then this six-hour training class is a requirement before obtaining the Limited Commercial Landscape Maintenance License (**erroneously called the Round-Up License.**) With this license you will be able to apply herbicides, fungicides, and insecticides on all but lawns and turfs.
